The governing board has a policy whereby members can be dismissed only for appropriate reasons and by a fair process.

Impact Statement

Baton Rouge Community College (BRCC) and Capital Area Technical College (CATC) were both members of the Louisiana Community and Technical College System (LCTCS). The merged BRCC continues as an institution governed by the LCTCS Board of Supervisors and the Louisiana constitutional statutes governing the conduct of its Board members.

Rationale

Members of the LCTCS Board of Supervisors serve as Public Officials of the State of Louisiana and, as such, are members of the unclassified state service. (Louisiana Constitution, Article X, Section 2, *Figure 3.2.3.1*). In accordance with state law, Board members shall be liable to removal from office by impeachment, for malfeasance or gross misconduct. Board members subject to a charge for removal shall be provided due process as provided in the Louisiana Constitution, Article X, Section 24 (*Figure 3.2.3.1*).
