Memorandum of Understanding

BETWEEN

**The College of Business of
Louisiana State University at Alexandria (LSUA)**



AND

**The Division of Business
Baton Rouge Community College (BRCC)**



2021-2022

By this memorandum, the College of Business of Louisiana State University at Alexandria (LSUA) and the Division of Business at Baton Rouge Community College (BRCC) agree to establish a 2+2 program that will allow students to transfer the 60 hours of coursework required by BRCC's Associate of Science in Business to LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and to earn the 60 additional hours of coursework required for completion of the bachelor's degree. LSUA and BRCC agree to offer the coursework required for completion 100% online.

Agreement Outline

Students who have earned the Associate of Science in Business from BRCC and who meet LSUA's admission requirements will be admitted to LSUA and be enrolled in the College of Business's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

The 60 credit hours that BRCC students earn to meet the requirements of the Associate of Science in Business will be accepted by LSUA and entered on their LSUA transcripts.

To ensure, however, that all 60 credit hours can be applied specifically to LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, BRCC students who intend to transfer to LSUA should follow the curriculum guide provided as an appendix to this document.

Students who follow the recommendations presented in the curriculum guide; and who complete the curriculum of BRCC's Associate of Science in Business; and who complete the remaining 60 hours required by LSUA's baccalaureate program; and who meet all other baccalaureate degree requirements specified in the LSUA Catalog, including the attainment of an overall GPA of 2.0 and a grade of "C" or higher in English Composition I and II and in all foundation and major courses, will be eligible to receive LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

BRCC students will follow the requirements of the LSUA Catalog in force at the time they enter BRCC provided the catalog is not earlier than the 2019-2020 catalog and provided students do not interrupt their enrollment at BRCC.

If the requirements for either degree program, BRCC's Associate of Science in Business or LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, change, the institution that has made the change will notify the other institution so that the curriculum guide for the two+two program can be modified accordingly.

Some courses required by both BRCC's Associate of Science in Business and LSUA's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration may require prerequisites. Students should consult the BRCC and LSUA catalogs for specific information.

BRCC students who have taken subject examinations in the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) or who have participated in the Advanced Placement Program of the College Board (AP) or who have superior ACT scores in English and/or MATH should have examination scores sent directly to Admissions. Official examination scores are then sent to the Office of the Registrar for review and posting of credit on student's transcript if applicable.

Program Evaluation

LSUA will evaluate on a regular basis the performance of 2+2 students and other transfer students in upper-level business courses and compare their performance to that of continuing LSUA students. If the performance of 2+2 students is significantly lower than
