- Applications are available each academic year in the spring semester and fall semester

- Entry into the RN program is **competitive. Meeting the minimum prerequisite and application requirements** does not guarantee acceptance into the program
- Entrance is determined by applicants' GPA in the 16 credit hours of prerequisites courses and ATI TEAS Exam Score

#### THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- THE DEADLINE WILL NOT BE EXTENDED.
- You must print and complete the one-page application (pg. 5) and send by Certified Mail it must be received by September 29, 2025– not postmarked September 29, 2025 allow time for delivery

- Applications will not be accepted by email or phone
- The TEAS Exam can be taken remotely through ATI <a href="https://www.atitesting.com/tea">https://www.atitesting.com/tea</a> (online from your home) or through the BRCC Testing Center for further information contact the Testing Center at <a href="testingcenter@mybrcc.edu">testingcenter@mybrcc.edu</a> (225) 216-8038. If you have previously taken the TEAS Exam within the last Five Years and scored a 65% or better that score may be used. You will need to print and attach that score to your application.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. All required information and a photograph must accompany the application for it to be accepted.
- You must submit with the application A PRINTED TRANSCRIPT showing a GRADE or "P" for all prerequisite classes, whether taken at BRCC and/or other institutions.
- If your course work was taken at other institution(s) and is visible on your BRCC transcript, you will ONLY NEED to submit one printed unofficial BRCC transcript ONLY. If course work from the other institution(s) is NOT visible, you must submit two (2) official printed transcripts for those institutions.
- TRANSCRIPTS FROM OTHER COLLEGES MUST BE OFFICIAL. If necessary, contact the issuing college to access their transcript services. Official transcripts may require a few days to a week or more to be issued to you and may require a payment. Do this early the application deadline is firm
  - You must attach a 2 INCH X 2 INCH COLOR PASSPORT PHOTO to the application.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

In order to be eligible for admission to the ASN Program, the applicant must first be admitted to Baton Rouge Community College (BRCC). The college application is available online at <a href="http://www.mybrcc.edu">http://www.mybrcc.edu</a>. The ASN Program application and all supporting documents must be received by the designated deadlines. <a href="https://www.mybrcc.edu">Applicants will not be considered for admittance to the ASN Program until all required documents have been submitted and the applicant's file is complete. A copy of the application and all supporting documents should be retained by the applicant since the program will not return the original application or any supporting documents. All correspondence will be sent to the applicant's permanent address or email listed on application. Admission to the ASN Program is competitive and will be based on the following criteria: 1) GPA in 16 credit hours of prerequisite courses, 2) student's score on the TEAS Exam.

It is important to note that simply meeting minimum requirements for admission to the nursing program does not guarantee admission. Also, all prerequisites are to be completed before you can apply to the ASN Program

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

STEP 1 BATON ROUGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS-In order to be considered for admission to the ASN Program you must be admitted to Baton Rouge Community College. If you are not already a BRCC student you must complete and meet the BRCC General Admission Requirements.

#### **STEP 2** ASN Program - ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant must have a GPA of 2.8 (not rounded) or higher in the following 16 credit hours of prerequisite courses
- 2. Applicant must have a grade of "C" or higher in the following 16 credit hours of prerequisite courses

If you have completed course work at another institution, and your credits are not posted to your BRCC transcript. YOU MUST SUBMIT 2 OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM EACH SCHOOL YOU HAVE ATTENDED.

#### WE WILL NOT ACCEPT:

- Electronic transcripts
- Unofficial transcripts from any school other than BRCC (only if viewable in your LOLA Account)
- Official transcript must be in a sealed envelope with the registrar stamp

#### The steps for viewing your transcripts in LOLA:

- Select the Student Tab
- Select Student Records
- Select Academic Transcripts
- 3. Applicant must have a passport photo (2"x2" color photo) to their application
- Applicants must take and pass the TEAS Exam with a minimum score or 65%. The TEAS Exam is taken through

#### **STEP 3 SELECTION NOTIFICATIONS**

- 1. All applicants will be notified of admission status (Admitted or Denied) after Mid-Term Fall 2025 Semester.
- 2. Applicants admitted to the nursing program will receive an acceptance letter and additional information regarding the following requirements:
  - a. Health History, Physical Examination, TB Skin Test and Immunizations
  - b. CPR
  - c. Criminal Background Check
- 3. Applicants who accept the offer for admission must attend a MANDATORY Pre-Admission Nursing Orientation. The Date, Time, and Location will be announced at a later date.
