



## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CHECKLIST

### International Freshmen Requirements

- Minimum TOEFL score of 500 on the paper test, 61 on the TOEFL iBT or IELTS score of 6.0
- Financial documents showing the availability of \$15,081 in USD for tuition and living expenses (additional \$6,000 for each dependent)
  - CANNOT BE OLDER THAN 3 MONTHS
- Statement of Financial Support
- Proof of Immunization Compliance
- Evaluated high school transcript
- Copy of passport
- Copy of F1 visa, if applicable
- Electronic I-94 Number (Can be acquired at [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov))

### International Transfer Requirements

- Minimum TOEFL score of 500 on the paper test or 61 on the TOEFL iBT
  - If you have completed college level English with a grade of a C or better, then you are not required to submit TOEFL scores
- Minimum IELTS score of 6.0
  - If you have completed college level English with a grade of a C or better, then you are not required to submit IELTS scores
- Financial documents showing the availability of \$15,081 in USD for tuition and living expenses (additional \$6,000 for each dependent)
  - CANNOT BE OLDER THAN 3 MONTHS
- Statement of Financial Support
- Proof of Immunization Compliance
- Evaluated high school transcript
  - Evaluated high school transcript must be submitted if you have acquired less than 12 credit hours from your previous institution(s)
- Official college transcript from all previous institutions
  - All college transcripts from non-U.S institutions must be evaluated
- Copy of passport
- Copy of F1 visa
- Copy of all previous I-20's
- Electronic I-94 Number (Can be acquired at [www.uscis.gov](http://www.uscis.gov))

### International Returning Requirements

- Financial documents showing the availability of \$15,081 in USD for tuition and living expenses (additional \$6,000 for each dependent)
  - CANNOT BE OLDER THAN 3 MONTHS
- If applicable, official college transcript from all previous institutions
